

### Session Munchies


- A total of \$82.49 was collected for Peace and Global Witness.

Income: 1/1/24 - 2/29/24 \$18,769.32 Expenses: 1/1/24 - 2/29/24 \$21,747.44 Difference -\$2.978.12

Income includes all funds received, i.e. general use and restricted use.

Expenses include all expenses including those paid from restricted use accounts such as Pot Love Dinners, Food Bank donations, etc.

There was also a large amount for church maintenance related to up-grades in the bathrooms, cleaning & waxing social hall floors, wall

repair and paint in office. The amount for theses items will be reimbursed to general funds from our Merrill Lynch account using the financial gift from Shirley Carnahan.


